Bishwambher Pyakuryal is a Professor of Economics at Tribhuvan University. Prof. Pyakuryal specializes in the areas of trade, investment, financial sector reform, conflict and economic liberalization & globalization. Dr. Pyakural is widely traveled professor having hundreds of publications. He has recently co-authored Nepal's Conflict: A Micro Impact Analysis on Economy.

Prof. Pyakuryal graduated with Masters and Doctoral degrees from Tribhuvan University in Economics. He also has a Masters of International Affairs with a major in Development Studies from Ohio University, USA. Prof. Pyakuryal is Post-Doctorate research in Economics at the University of Maryland at College Park, USA. He has thirty-three years of university career.

Prof. Pyakuryal is on the editorial boards of the Economic journal of Nepal, a publication of Tribhuvan University and of the South Asian Economic journal, a joint publication by the Institute of Policy Studies, Sri Lanka and RIS, New Delhi, India.
